

## Set up Active Directory to support Edge’s Internet Explorer mode

In the EBS Portal, technologies designed to work using Microsoft Internet Explorer (for which Microsoft will end support June 15, 2022) will continue to work in Microsoft Edge instead, using “Internet Explorer” (IE) mode. In order for people to use IE mode, settings must be adjusted in their Edge browser. These settings can be done using group policy.

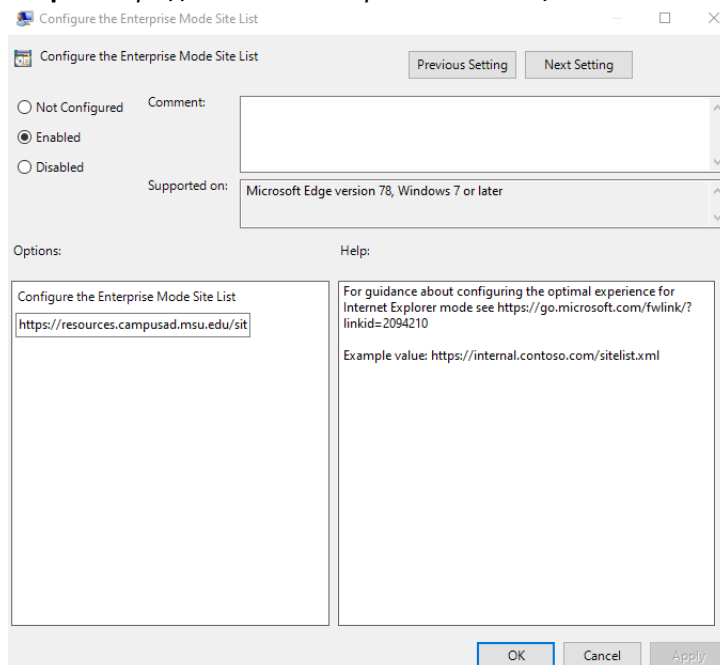
### Steps: Part One

Apply Internet Explorer Integration and Enterprise Mode Site List

1. Open Group Policy Management Console
2. Edit a Group Policy and expand folder
  - a. Computerconfiguration\Policies\Administrative Templates: Policy definitions (ADMX files)
 

**Note:** Retrieved from the central store (if applicable)
  - b. Enable the policy: “Configure Internet Explorer integration” and set the Configure Internet Explorer integration to “Internet Explorer Mode”
  - c. Enable the policy: “Configure the Enterprise Mode Site List and under “Options” and “Configure the Enterprise Mode Site List” add the URL:

3. Link GPO to Desired OU
 

**Note:** This policy does not append to any existing exceptions set in other sites.xml files if administratively set

## Steps: Part Two

Apply InternetExplorerIntegrationReloadInIEModeAllowed

1. Open Group Policy Management Console
2. Edit a Group Policy and expand folder  
Computerconfiguration\Policies\Administrative Templates: Policy definitions (ADMX files)

**Note:** Retrieved from the central store (if applicable)

3. In Microsoft Edge enable the setting  
“Allow unconfigured sites to be reloaded in Internet Explorer mode”
4. Link GPO to Desired OU

**Note:** You may want to reduce scope of this policy as needed within your organization
